The Oconto Falls School District is seeking a skilled, compassionate, and highly motivated Alternative School Teacher for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. This position will have duties focused within the alternative school programs, but applicants with other areas of interest and experience are encouraged to apply.

I. Desired Qualifications:

1. Knowledgeable/experienced in the following areas:
 - Successful experience in an alternative school setting at the high school level
 - Experience in individualized learning plans and implementing these individualized plans
 - Knowledge of project based learning or alternative learning options based on student strengths and interests
 - Experience with virtual learning opportunities and utilizing this form of instruction with students
 - Successful experience with at-risk youth and abilities/strategies to build relationships with students
 - Experience in working with adolescents with mental health or social/emotional challenges
 - Knowledge and experience in developing and modifying behavioral intervention plans
 - Excellent interpersonal communication skills, both written and verbal
 - Experience supporting students from school to work and facilitating this process
 - Experience collaborating with outside agencies to support adolescents
 - Demonstrating strong organization skills, flexibility and teamwork
 - Ability to work independently when needed and communicate with a team to help support learning for students

II. Requirements:

1. Must have appropriate DPI license as a regular education or special education teacher, in addition to the supplemental alternative education program license or be eligible to obtain proper certification
2. The ideal candidate will have successful leadership experience and additional skills in alignment with our district initiatives
3. Exceptional ability/experience with building relationships with students, staff, and community members
4. Creating positive cultures focused on learning

III. Terms of Employment:

1. Salary to be established by the Board of Education on an annual basis.

IV. Evaluation:

1. Performance of this job will be evaluated annually in the employees first two years of employment and at a minimum, every three years thereafter by the Director of Pupil Services or their designee.
