A current Wisconsin Teacher License with a certification in Mathematics (400) is required for this position.

- Commitment to high expectations for student achievement;
- Ability to innovate and differentiate instruction;
- Ability to ensure a positive and supportive learning environment;
- Ability to establish and maintain positive working relationships with staff, students, and parents;
- Desire to work in a collaborative setting;
- Possess strong interpersonal skills, including effective written and verbal communication
- Desire to fully integrate into school community by advising, and/or coaching.
- Bilingual/ELL experience/skills is a plus.

II. Requirements:

1. Must have appropriate DPI license (1400 Mathematics) or be eligible to obtain proper certification
2. The ideal candidate will have successful leadership experience and additional skills in alignment with our district initiatives
3. Exceptional ability/experience with building relationships with students, staff, and community members
4. Creating positive cultures focused on learning

III. Terms of Employment:

1. Salary to be established by the Board of Education on an annual basis.
