MAKE ONLINE PAYMENTS FOR LUNCHES AND SUMMER SCHOOL FEES

Step 1: Go to: https://ofps.RevTrak.net

Create a RevTrak account using your email address and a password.

Step 2: You will be asked to enter your Skyward Family Access Login.

Future transactions won't require two steps because your account will now be linked to your Skyward fees. You will simply log in using the account you created above.

Step 3: Click on "Purchase Food" or "Purchase Fees" to view account balances. Click a quick pay button or enter your payment in the amount field. If using a mobile device, scroll down to view balances or fees. Make selections and click "add Selected to Cart".

Step 4: Enter your payment method and place your order. After your transaction is processed, you will receive an email confirmation and your student's Skyward account will be updated
