| SSCON    | SS CONSTRUCTION  | This class is designed for current woodworking students in order to have them gain valuable onsite work experience prior to their building construction debut. In this class students can anticipate constructing a significant residential structure focusing on current building techniques. Due to the nature of construction, we worked 8 to 9 hour days on fair weather days, while having the student's log 70 hours of lab time in order to gain their ½ credit on their transcript. This usually takes the first two weeks of summer. Occasionally a student has something that comes up causing them to miss lab times, to avoid having them not receive credit for completing the class, I have offered additional meeting times. This is set up on an individual bases with instructor approval. This class, if taken two summers, serves as the prerequisite for building construction, eliminating introduction to construction from the school year class load if requested by the student. If an exemplarily student, this class can serve as the gateway for all high school students 9th to 12th to be eligible for August Construction in which the students earn a wage instead of credit for lab time.
